

How do I access the BLE?

To access the BLE, also known as Moodle, go to the front page of the SOAS website www.soas.ac.uk and click on the 'Bloomsbury Learning Environment login' link




Alternatively you can go to the site directly by typing <http://ble.soas.ac.uk> into your browser address bar

On the very top right hand side, above the SOAS tree logo, there is a login link



How Do I find My Courses?

For the first 3 weeks of term

Search courses:

You can search using all or part of the course name or the course code. Generally using the course code is more accurate as many courses at SOAS have similar names. Bear in mind that we keep two years' worth of courses on the BLE at the start of the year. You can distinguish between the two by looking at the year extensions. Course codes will have –A13/14 for last years' courses or –A14/15 for this year's course. The course names should now also say –A14/15 etc.

Search courses:

Clicking on the link of the appropriate course will take you into the course itself

After the first 3 weeks of term

Once you have completed online enrolment your courses will start to be passed to the BLE. The BLE is updated twice a day, midnight and midday, from the student records system (UNITe). As your courses are loaded onto the BLE you will start to see them appear by clicking on the 'My Home' link in the navigation block



Please bear in mind it takes time for enrolments to be checked, approved and loaded so be patient. If your courses have still not all appeared on you're my Home page by 3 weeks into term you will need to check with your Faculty Office.
