

## Using the London Underground

If you are visiting London, a Visitor Oyster Card is faster and cheaper than paying with paper tickets or cash for the bus, tube, tram, DLR, London Overground and most National Rail services. To purchase an Oyster Card, simply inquire at the nearest transit station.

### From Heathrow Airport

Heathrow Airport and Russell Square are both on the Piccadilly Tube Line (approximately 45 minutes), there is also the Heathrow Express train service which runs to Paddington, from Paddington you can get the Circle or Hammersmith & City Lines to Euston Square.

### From Gatwick Airport

From Gatwick trains run into Victoria Station (approximately 30 minutes) then take the Victoria Line to Warren Street or King's Cross/St Pancras.

### From Heathrow Airport

The Heathrow Express train service runs to Paddington, from Paddington you can get the Circle or Hammersmith & City Lines to Euston Square.

### From Gatwick Airport
