

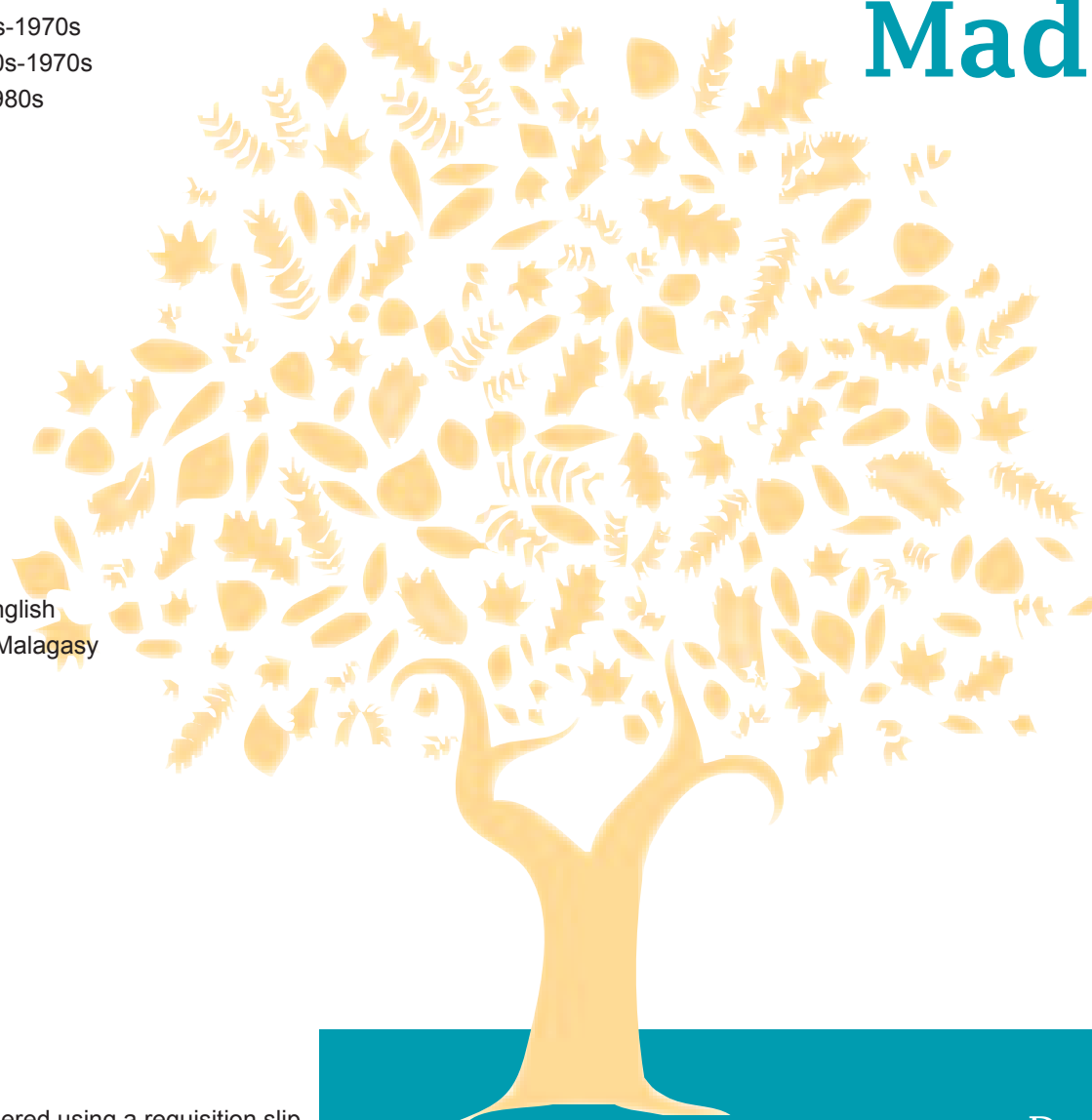

Introduction

- The largest personal collection on Madagascar in existence, donated to SOAS Library in 1991 by the retired missionary, Rev. James Hardyman and his wife, Marjorie
- Complements the Library's own Madagascar collections in the:
 - Africa Section (Level D - classmark WY): European-language material on Madagascar
 - S.E. Asia Section (Level C - class-mark IBI): Malagasy languages
 - Archive and Library of the Council for World Mission/London Missionary Society (Level F, Special Collections Reading Room)

Contents

- 3,000 publications in English, French and Malagasy; also Norwegian, Welsh and other languages
- Broad subject range, principally church and mission history in Madagascar, history, anthropology, Malagasy language. Smaller sections cover geography, geology, flora and fauna, law, music and hymnology, arts and crafts, medicine, numismatics and philately

Location

- Main collection. Class-mark WYM (Level D)
- Old or rare books. Class-mark E WYM: closed-access material ordered and consulted in the Special Collections Reading Room (Level F)
- James Hardyman's private papers: correspondence, manuscripts, research notes and photographs. Class-mark PP MS 63: closed-access material ordered and consulted in the Special Collections
- Reading Room (Level E)

Browsing

- Main collection can be browsed on the open shelves; online catalogue enables searches for specific books, authors or subjects - or for categories of material such as rare books
- Online class-mark search for WYM and E WYM will bring up all publications held in the Hardyman Madagascar Collection
- James Hardyman's private papers are separately catalogued on the Archives and Manuscripts Database in the Special Collections Reading Room (Level F)
- Remote access The Hardyman Madagascar Collection (excluding private papers) is fully catalogued online. Internet access at www.soas.ac.uk/library
