

John Taylor Music Travel Grants

Each year, two awards valued at £500 will be made available to Department of Music 2nd year Undergraduates and Postgraduate Taught Masters students. These awards may be used to fund travel expenses in the pursuit of research as part of an independent study project or dissertation.

The John Taylor Music Travel Awards are made to help to promote and develop knowledge and understanding of the musics of Asia and Africa and their Diasporas, by supporting student research visits during the summer vacation.

Each project will be assessed on its objective merits. The candidate must show that he/she has the time and the ability to complete it satisfactorily. Carefully considered projects which look at a small defined area of study will be more likely to succeed than projects which propose to look at a general overview of a subject. The academic performance and profile of the student will be taken into consideration in so far as it is an indicator of the student's ability to complete the project satisfactorily.

The closing date for applications is the Monday after Reading Week of term 2. Completed application forms should be emailed to the Head of Music.

After completion of the research project, the award recipients are required to submit a report of approximately 500 words to the Head of Music.

Awards are payable against receipts, which should be submitted to the Head of Music.
