#### References

Referees should provide an opinion on the applicant's suitability for the programme of study as a scholarship student. References must be in English and must be provided by to the scholarship application closing date.

### **English Language**

Where an applicant's offer of admission to the SOAS Postgraduate Diploma in Asian Art includes an English language condition, any scholarship award will be conditional on having met that condition by 14 August 2023.

#### **Candidate Assessment**

- Candidates will be assessed by an Advisory Panel consisting of three members of SOAS staff.
- The panel will be looking at the applicants' degree results, references, professional experience, supporting statement, writing sample, and other relevant information.
- The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of a combination of academic potential, financial need, and impact of the scholarship on the applicant's academic and professional development.

### **Pre-Application Requirement**

Applicants must already hold an offer for the Postgraduate Diploma in Asian Art (conditional or unconditional) prior to submitting a scholarship application.

#### **Closing Date**

All applications should be submitted before **23.59** (UK time) on **Sunday 02 July 2023**. Scholarship applicants will be notified of the outcome of their applications by Friday 14 July 2023.

### Scholarship Terms

- The scholarship cannot be held along with any other major scholarship.
- The successful candidate is expected to attend all teaching sessions.
- Continuation of the award will be conditional on satisfactory attendance and contribution, which will be assessed at the end of every term as well as monitored throughout.
- Successful applicants must be able to make the remaining half-fee payment four weeks in advance of each module's start date.
