Department/School	Please Note
<u>Economics</u>	Students from departments other than Economics wishing to take more advanced year 2 or year 3 modules in Economics as their open option modules, MUST consult the module convenor of their chosen open option PRIOR to signing up for this module on the precise level and type of prior economics knowledge is required. This can vary between modules, depending on a number of factors, such as whether these are general theory modules, specialised regional development modules, modules with a strong microeconomic or strong macroeconomic contents, and/or largely applied empirical modules. Please note that it is in the students' own best interest to consult module convenors in this regard prior to signing up for any more advanced Economic open options in order to ensure their successful completion of their open option modules.
<u>History</u>	Second and third year students may take one of the Year 2/3 modules (subject to the approval of the module convenor and the module running). Year 3 advanced modules can only be taken if the student has taken a relevant introductory or intermediate module.
<u>Law</u>	Students majoring in Law can choose School of Law modules from the tab 'Law Majors Only'. Only Postgraduate Law students can choose PG modules. Students not majoring in Law who wish to take a School of Law module, shall only choose one from the "Non-Language Open Module".
<u>All Languages</u>	Students will need to take a placement test before the start of semester to determine the suitable level of language module for them. Please select the level you consider most appropriate when choosing module. You may be moved up or down on the level depending on the outcome of the test.

You are required to take 4 modules per semester.

Prerequisite means you need to fulfil the requirements set out by the convenor. This can be modules in your home institution equivalent to the one listed in the prerequisite. You need to get the approval from the convenor by email and send it back to us.

Corequisite means you are required to enrol into the other module listed as well. Semester-only students may request to enrol to one of the modules but subject to approval by convenors.

Postgraduate modules are only open to students joining the postgraduate study abroad / exchange programme.

Semester 1-only students should not select modules with an exam as assessment unless it is necessary for their curriculum in their home institution. You will be asked to provide a written confirmation and approval from the study abroad office at your home institution to enrol in these modules.
