Creating search alerts

In both basic and advanced search you'll see a **create alert** button beside the search box. If you select this after including your search terms in the search box(es) you can create an alert to be sent to you by e-mail (or an RSS feed), when new content on your research topic is added.

What is EBSCO Discovery Service (EDS)?

EBSCO Discovery Service (EDS) is a research discovery tool; which allows you to search across a huge range of databases, e-journals, e-books, reports, multimedia items and more. EDS doesn't include all of SOAS' subscription e-resources (e.g. Proquest products aren't currently included), but it does provide a quick and easy starting point for your research.
